Initial Takeaways

State-wide Agencies spend about 88% of their Supportive Service budgets on salary and fringe

Overwhelmingly, agencies are struggling to pay staff a competitive wage



Roughly \$28,000,000 is spent yearly on salary and fringe across the state in HUD CoC projects.

We propose that we ask for \$7,500,000 in supplemental funds from the State of Illinois.


Total Supportive Services Funding Statewide: \$31,989,893


Total Supportive Service Funding Statewide - Salary and Fringe: \$28,151,342

Next Steps


In order to receive supplemental funds, agencies would have to be GATA-certified






SHPA will be announcing the initiative as a priority at the Supportive Housing Summit on November 16th and 17th
