## Supportive Housing

- Is housing units for people with low incomes and disabilities (or multiple barriers to community living) <u>PLUS</u> the social/health services that they want and need.
- Is affordable, permanent, independent, and helps people live with stability, autonomy and dignity.
- Is not intended for every population that needs access to affordable housing.

### **Overview of the SRN/811 units**

### What is the Statewide Referral Network (SRN)?

The Network is a partnership of State Agencies and Social Service Providers that allows for the pairing of households with available housing units.





## **SRN Eligibility**

- People who earn under 30% of the Area Median income AND:
- People in institutions or at risk of institutionalization, OR
- People experiencing homelessness or at risk, OR
- People with disabilities including:
- Williams, Colbert, and Ligas class members



## **SRN Rent Determination:**

- Affordable Housing– Rent is set to be affordable to a household earning under 30% AMI
- Income Based Housing Rent is based on annual household Income and is targeted to income ranges
- Subsidized Housing Rent is typically based on 30% of household income

### HUD 811 Eligibility

- People who earn under 30% of the Area Median income AND:
- People under 62 AND receiving Medicaid Long Term Services and Supports or State Medicaid Plan Services AND:
- In institutions or at risk of institutionalization including
   ALL HUD 811 UNITS ARE SUBSIDIZED

Filter your clients by using the "Offers needing response" quick link on the NEW dashboard. Click on the blue house next to the applicant name to navigate to the page to express interest in the unit.





On the Open Offers page, use the radio buttons to indicate if your client is interested or not interested in the unit and then select the "Acknowledge Offers" button at the bottom of the table. Your response will be recorded on the client record.

- Apply for the unit like any other affordable housing unit, completing the application on site or as instructed.
- Property then processes the application like any other rental application and reviews it against the Tenant Selection Plan
- You will need:
  - Picture ID
  - Social Security Card
  - Birth Certificate (for all people in the household)
  - Income verification/Proof of Income (e.g., check stubs, Social Security award letter)
- Lease is signed and resident provides deposit/first month's rent
- Reasonable accommodation and modification\*\*





### **Reasonable Accommodations/Modifications**

- Due to a disability, Household has needs that do not fit standard processes
  - At Application
  - At Screening
  - At Move in
  - Any time

How do I help people access a reasonable accommodation?	Request this of the property manager either at the time of application or after. Ask CSH for help if you would like assistance.





## Frequently Asked Questions

Question	Answer
How do I know if the participant is entered correctly on the PAIR Module?	Within two business days you will see their status change from pending to Waiting: Approved
What if the participant is not the first person referred to the unit?	They may still have an opportunity to apply and move in as others may drop out of the process. If not, they will go back on the waiting list for other offers.
If the household no longer needs housing, what do I do?	You can remove people from the PAIR Module by changing their status from Waiting: Approved to a Removed status option.
